Weapons and Optics License and Legal ☐ Rifle or Shotgun: □ Valid ID (Required) (Required) ☐ Hunting License - function as intended by the original manufacturer ☐ Hunt-permit tags - Meet hunting regulations (ARS R12-4-303 A) - Ammunition must fit firearms you bring - non-permit tag for bear - optics of your choice, zeroed before arrival - non-permit tag for mountain lion We need these in-person for AZGFD reporting We cannot hunt if you forget them. (ARS R12-4-208 R) **Hunting Accessories Clothing** ☐ Shooting Sticks, tripod, or tall bipods ☐ Hiking boots or shoes: - 30 to 40"+ height - sturdy, over-the-ankle boots with proper tread - we do not recommend shooting freehand and support. ☐ Binoculars and Range Finder ☐ Layered and appropriate clothing: - chest harness - camo or neutral/earth tones are ok ☐ Drag ropes ☐ Facemask ☐ Seating (stools or pads) ☐ Gloves ☐ Hat Temperatures and conditions can vary.
